Aloha Everybody,

I'm sure you will be happy to know that we have updated the total look of our website adding new graphics, a more contemporary look, expanded access for owners and new security features. We would like you to go online as soon as you can and check it out and set up your new user name and password. Each unit is now assigned two user names based on your Unit Number: they will be, for example: C303-1 and C303-2. Most of our Units have two owners so now both will be able get our emails. Why did we make this security change? Our website has had the same User Name and Password, the same for everybody, since the website was launched about 10 years ago. Right now, Owners, who moved away years ago, would still be able to access the Owners Section of our website. We believed that was not a good idea for many and obvious reasons, so now entry will be limited to only current owners. When Owners move away, the Office will delete their Password information; the Unit Numbers, of course, will be permanent awaiting a new Owner.

We will also revive the Coconut Wireless newsletter under the new title of Royal Happenings. This newsletter will be emailed to you quarterly giving you information not only on what is going on at Kaanapali Royal, with input from Chuck and Kehau, but also any pertinent information we think you should know about on issues on Maui that might affect you and might affect Kaanapali Royal, issues coming from both the County and the State.

HOW TO ACCESS THE NEW WEBSITE

The new website will have the same web address as the old one: www.kaanapaliroyal.com
Please follow these instructions when going to the Owners Area of the new website for the first time:

1. Click "Owners Area" in the top right corner of the page
2. A "log in" screen will now pop up
3. Each Unit has now been assigned two User Names based on your Unit Number
i.e. C303-1 and C303-2 as most of our Units have two Owners
4. So now, under User Name, type in your Unit Number with a dash 1 (the second person can go in later with a dash 2 and a different email address)
5. Go to Password: type in: kaanowner
6. You can now view the Owners Area. Please update your Password at this time. To do this you will simply click on your User Name in the top right hand corner of the page (the part with the black background). You will now see an "Edit My Profile" page. Here you can now put in your own Password which I encourage you do.

We were very lucky to have Mike Wigglesworth, one of our owners, a professional and experienced web designer, put this all together for us. The look, the graphics, the layout are all his and I'm very pleased with the result and I hope you are too.

Going forward, the Office is currently being trained to post data to the website so the Minutes of our Meetings and the President's Letter will be posted on the website and the Office will email you when they are available.
